Lincoln County 4-H Youth Behavior Guidelines

As representatives of Lincoln County 4-H, members are expected to adhere to the following Behavior Guidelines. Members will:

- Follow the rules and regulations of the Wisconsin and Lincoln County 4-H Program.
- Treat other 4-H members and leaders with respect.
- Behave in accordance with applicable federal, state and municipal law. This includes:
 - Members will not, under any circumstances, consume or possess any alcoholic beverages, illegal drugs, or tobacco products. **NO EXCEPTIONS!**
 - Members will refrain from sexual misconduct.
- Refrain from use of objectionable language (includes swearing and slanderous comments) and horseplay.
- Respect public and personal property.

Any members violating the above rules, (as determined by the Lincoln County 4-H Leaders' Association, Inc. and/or Lincoln County 4-H Youth Development Agent or Program Advisor), will be subject to any or all of the following consequences:

1. Notification of parents or guardians.
 2. Notification of club leaders.
 3. Notification of law enforcement, if there is reason to believe it is necessary.
 4. Individual may be required to appear before the 4-H Leaders' Association Board to explain his/her actions.
 5. Revocation of privilege to participate in 4-H sponsored programs.
- Youth and their families agree to follow the Junior and Open Division Exhibitors Code of Conduct and Exhibition Agreement for the Lincoln County 4-H Fair:
 - Follow the general rules and regulations governing entries, exhibits, judging, and payment of premiums as stated in the fair exhibitor's handbook.
 - Follow any rules relating specifically to a department in which they are exhibiting.
 - Exhibit proper conduct according to the following guidelines:
 - Show respect for the rights of others and be courteous at all times.
 - Demonstrate sportsmanship in the show ring, judging contests, and meetings.
 - Be honest and not take unfair advantage of others.

Any exhibitor violating the above rules (as determined by Department Chairpersons, Lincoln County 4-H Board of Directors, Fair Board Directors, judges, or UW-Extension staff) will be subject to any one or all of the following consequences:

1. Notification of parents or guardians (if applicable).
2. Removal of individual and any or all of his/her exhibits from the present year's fair. Any premiums earned will be revoked.
3. Judges may disqualify an exhibit or give it a lower placing if the rules are not followed.
4. The individual may be required to appear before a joint meeting of the Lincoln County 4-H Leaders' Association Board of Directors and Fair Board and/or other committees responsible for the project area in question to explain his or her actions.
5. Revocation of privilege to enter exhibits in future Lincoln County 4-H Fairs.
